



Sumner Tunnel Summer 2023 Closure

Transit Commuting Alternatives

The Sumner Tunnel will be closed seven days a week from July 5th, 2023 to August 31st, 2023. To minimize travel delays and impact, transit commuting is encouraged. Please visit mass.gov/sumner-tunnel for project updates.

Benefits-eligible, active Harvard parking permit holders must return their permit by May 25, 2023 in order to access the transit benefit and transportation debit card.

Subsidized monthly transit passes

- Benefits-eligible employees can purchase a 50% subsidized, pre-tax, monthly transit pass by June 4, 2023 at transportation.harvard.edu/edenred.

Pre-tax savings for flexible transit and parking

- Benefits-eligible employees can add money to a transportation debit card to access pre-tax savings at transportation.harvard.edu/edenred.
- Purchase flexible transit passes on the MTicket app or at an MBTA kiosk, tickets for regional transit operators, and transit station parking.

Discounted transit station parking

- \$2 daily parking will be offered at all Blue Line stations, and Salem and Swampscott Commuter Rail stations.
